FIRST USE

- Remove all packaging and point of sale labels before use.
- Remove plastic cover from plug before use.

 (used to protect it from damage during transportation)

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Towel dry and detangle hair.
- 2. Plug the appliance into a suitable mains socket.
- 3. Select the required heat and speed settings.
- After use, switch off and unplug the appliance.
- 5. Allow to cool before storing away.

IMPORTANT! Always keep the rear of the appliance away from the hair during use to prevent it being drawn in through the rear air filter.

CAUTION: Take care not to direct the airflow directly onto the skin (e.g. scalp, neck ears, face, etc.) as hot air from the hairdryers can, particularly if held too close, cause discomfort or even burns.

IMPORTANT: We do not recommend using this styler if your hair has been heavily bleached or chemically treated. Please consult your hairdresser on using heated appliances if you have any concerns about the condition of your hair.

STYLE TIPS

STRAIGHT

// Create a smooth straight look by using your dryer with the concentrator nozzle. Divide your hair into sections & hold the hair taut using a brush whilst directing the airflow down the hair shaft.

VOLUME

// Create tousled natural-looking waves with lots of volume by using your dryer without the nozzle. Flip your head upside down. Grasp your hair at the roots & scrunch between your fingertips whilst drying. When dry, finger comb to arrange your hair as required. Remember to keep it casual & tousled for maximum volume.

CURLS

Enhance your natural curls by using your dryer with the diffuser on the lowest speed setting & lowest heat setting: it literally diffuses and softens the airflow, which helps to form, not frizz, your curls.

EXPERT TIP

// Set your style by finishing with the cool shot or setting. Finish with a spritz of light hold hair spray, for extra hold if needed.

HEAT AND SPEED SETTINGS

There are 3 heat and 2 speed settings plus a cool shot button to 'set' hair for longer lasting results. We recommend trying the lowest speed and heat settings to start with and build up to find your comfort level. Even at the lower settings, this drver will deliver a highly effective blow dry and achieve beautiful results. Only use a higher heat/speed combination to initially dry hair, then step down to a cooler heat and lower speed to finish drying and for styling. This more gentle drying regime will care for delicate hair and will help making drying more comfortable

SPEED & HEAT COMBINATIONS

Low & Cool - Use the low speed and cool setting for more gentle drying with less penetrating airflow. This is a more comfortable setting on regrowing or

Low & Warm - Increasing to the warm setting will help speed up drying whilst the low airflow will still provide a really gentle blow dry.

Low & Hot - The low speed and hot setting will dry hair more quickly but the gentle airflow prevents this setting from feeling too hot.

High & Cool – Use the high speed and cool setting for cooler drying with a more penetrating airflow to dry hair more swiftly.

High & Warm - The high speed and warm setting is a really efficient drying combination for fast drying without being too hot.

High & Hot - The high speed and hot setting is a highly efficient drying combination for initial fast drying or for thicker hair that feels comfortable with higher heat.

COOL SHOT BUTTON

Use the cool shot button on warm hair to rapidly cool the hair and set the style in place, for a long lasting effect.

SLIM CONCENTRATOR NOZZLE

Use the slim concentrator nozzle to direct the airflow along the hair section to make styling easier.

DIFFUSER

IMPORTANT: Only use the diffuser with your dryer on the lowest heat settings. Use the diffuser to build life, volume and curls in short to medium length hair, or crunch with your hands and follow with diffuser. Shampoo and towel dry your hair. Hang your head forward and aim the diffuser upwards so that the warm air circulates freely through your hair. When dry, toss your head back for a stunning casual look

CAUTION: Take care not to direct the airflow directly onto the skin (e.g. scalp. neck, ears, face, etc.) as hot air from hairdryers can, particularly if held too close, cause discomfort or even burns.

STYLING TIPS

To create body and volume in the hair, use a brush or your fingers to brush the hair in the opposite direction to how it would naturally fall. Direct the airflow towards the roots for maximum lift. Once dry, neaten the hair and brush it back into place. To create a smooth straight look, first divide the hair into sections. Attach the slim concentrator nozzle then use a brush to take up a hair section and hold it taut. Direct the concentrator nozzle along the hair section to dry.

USER MAINTENANCE

Blocked or clogged air intake vents will cause the dryer to overheat. The rear filter should be checked and cleaned on a regular basis. To help maintain optimum performance and prevent overheating of your hairdryer:

- Ensure that your styler is switched off, unplugged from the power outlet and has cooled down.
- Holding the handle of your styler firmly, pull the hinged rear filter down.
- Using a soft brush, clean any hair and other debris that may build up in the
- Replace the hinged rear filter by pushing back into position.

If overheating occurs, an automatic safety device will shut the dryer or the heat off to prevent damage or personal injury. If the dryer or heat turns off, unplug the cord and allow the dryer to cool for 15 minutes before restarting. Make sure the air vents are 100% clean.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

The following safety precautions should always be followed when using electrical appliances, especially when children are present in your household. Please read these instructions carefully and keep for future reference.

- WARNING: Do not use this appliance in or near bathtubs, showers, water Keep the appliance dry.
- When this appliance is used in a bathroom, unplug it after use since the proximity of water presents a hazard even when the hairdryer is switched off
- If this appliance falls into water, unplug it immediately DO NOT reach into the water.

WARNINGS: Before and During Use

- Before using, always ensure that the voltage marked on the appliance is the same as your local power voltage.
- If the appliance is designed to be connected to a detachable power supply (otherwise known as a charger or adaptor), the appliance must only be used with the power supply it was sold with.
- Do not operate this appliance or disconnect from the power supply with
